MOAB A FAILURE BECAUSE HE REFUSED TO CHANGE

(Sons and Daughters of God, EGW, Pg. 97)

Moab hath been at ease from his youth, and he hath settled on his lees, and hath not been emptied from vessel to vessel, neither hath he gone into captivity: therefore his taste remained in him, and his scent is not changed. Jeremiah 48:11.

A man may refuse to hear the counsels and admonitions of God. He may choose to take the regulating of his conduct into his own hands.... Like Moab, he refuses to be changed.... He refuses to correct his defective traits of character, although the Lord has plainly pointed out his work, his privileges, his opportunities, and the advancement to be made. It is too much trouble to break up his old ways, and transform his ideas and methods. "His taste remained in him." He clings to his defects.

There are many who are not satisfied with the work that God has given them. They are not satisfied to serve Him pleasantly in the place that He has marked out for them, or to do uncomplainingly the work that He has placed in their hands. It is right for us to be dissatisfied with the way in which we perform duty, but we are not to be dissatisfied with the duty itself, because ... in His providence God places before human beings service that will be as medicine for their diseased minds.... Some He places where relaxed discipline and over-indulgence will not become their snare, where they are taught to appreciate the value of time, and to make the best and wisest use of it.

There are some who desire to be a ruling power, and who need the sanctification of submission.... They are being qualified to fill places where their disciplined ability will make them of the greatest service. Some God trains by bringing to them disappointment and apparent failure. It is His purpose that they shall learn to master difficulty....

Many are ignorant of how to work for God, not because they need to be ignorant, but because they are not willing to submit to His training process. Moab is spoken of as a failure because, the Word declares, "he hath been at ease from his youth."

WRONG PHYSICAL HABITS AFFECT THE BRAIN!

Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31.

The character of the food and the manner in which it is eaten exert a powerful influence on the health. Many ... have never made a determined effort to control the appetite, or to observe proper rules in regard to eating. Some eat too much at their meals, and some eat between meals whenever the temptation is presented.

The need of carefulness in habits of diet should be impressed on the minds of all.... I appeal to all to refuse to

eat those things that will injure the health. Thus they can serve the Lord by sacrifice.

Those who obey the laws of health will give time and thought to the needs of the body and to the laws of digestion. And they will be rewarded by clearness of thought and strength of mind. On the other hand it is possible for one to spoil his Christian experience by abuse of the stomach. Those things that derange the digestion have a benumbing influence on the finer feelings of the heart.... Every habit that injures the health reacts upon the mind. That time is well spent which is directed to the establishment and preservation of sound physical and mental health. Firm, quiet nerves and a healthy circulation help men to follow right principles and to listen to the promptings of conscience....



The brain is the citadel of the being. Wrong physical habits affect the brain, and prevent the attainment of ... good mental discipline. Unless the youth are versed in the science of how to care for the body as well as for the mind, they will not be

successful students. Study is not the principal cause of breakdown of the mental powers. The main cause is improper diet, irregular meals, a lack of physical exercise, and careless inattention in other respects to the laws of health. When we do all that we can to preserve the health, then we can ask God in faith to bless our efforts....

The youth should be taught that they are not at liberty to do as they please with their lives. God will not hold guiltless those who treat lightly His precious gifts. Men should realize that the greater their endowment of strength, of talent, of means, or of opportunities, the more heavily should the burden of God's work rest upon them, and the more they should do for Him. The youth who are trained to believe that life is a sacred trust will hesitate to plunge into the vortex of dissipation and crime that swallows up so many promising young men of this age. The less feverish the diet, the more easily can the passions be controlled. Gratification of taste should not be consulted irrespective of physical, intellectual, or moral health....

HOW GOD USED A DRYER BALL TO REASSURE ME

A strange thing happened to me at a camp meeting in Spokane this September. It all started with a missing dryer ball earlier in the month before the camp meeting.

For those who do not know what dryer balls are, they are made of either silicone or pressed wool typically the size of tennis balls that you put in the dryer with your clothes to prevent static cling. I had purchased four of the uncommon smaller silicone variety about the size of ping pong balls before leaving for the camp meeting. They were pink and spikey and, well, cute.

They were unusual and not like any dryer balls I had seen. I managed to lose one of them after my very first dryer



load. I searched everywhere – behind the dryer, beside the dryer, under the refrigerator, under the couch, between the cushions, in the nooks and crannies of the house, in all clothing and sheets and towels

that came out of the dryer. Gone. Disappeared. I suspected Barnabas the cat had something to do with it and figured it would show up when we rearranged the furniture at some distant point in the future.

You may be wondering what this has to do with a camp meeting in Spokane. Well, my husband Gerald and I drove six hours to a lovely lodge on a lake north of Spokane to listen to speakers from ministries we support and fellowship with friends for a few days. The first night we arrived I became very ill with terrible stomach cramps. I was doubled over in pain for a couple of hours that evening and unable to attend the last meeting for the night. Nothing we tried seemed to abate the pain -a warm towel to the stomach, ginger tea, and charcoal - nothing seemed to work, and the pain began to increase. Poor Gerald was confounded with worry and how to fix me. He wanted to drive to the nearest town for some antacid, but I was afraid for him to leave me for so long, AND we had some car trouble in Spokane on the way to the camp meeting. I had imagined him breaking down somewhere and unable to get back. He prayed for me and then left in search of a piece of dry toast to settle my stomach. The meetings had ended and no one could be found.

While he was gone, I knelt beside the bed with my head on the mattress. I began to pray and ask the Lord what was wrong with me. "What's wrong, Lord??" Then it entered my mind to praise the Lord and thank Him. I recalled many scriptures praising God with thankfulness. Despite my brain fog and pain, scriptures came to my mind. The pain began to ease but I was afraid to move. Shortly after the pain began to abate, Gerald came back with a piece of dry toast but I was not able to eat much of it, just a nibble. When I stood up I realized quite suddenly I was going to be sick and hurried to the bathroom. I will spare you the details at this point, but suffice it to say, I emerged from the bathroom completely pain-free as if it never happened. Gerald, in utter relief, said, "YOU NEED TO GO TO BED RIGHT NOW AND SLEEP FOR THE REST OF THE NIGHT." He never commands me to do anything, but he was pretty worried.

I brushed my teeth, put on my PJ's, and pulled the bedding back and crawled in. Upon stretching my legs out under the covers my foot touched something at the foot of the bed. I thought, "No, it couldn't be..." Then I reached with my hand and pulled up a dryer ball – not the typical tennis ball sized blue dryer ball or pressed wool that everyone uses - rather the little pink spikey weird dryer ball exactly like the one that went missing from my dryer in Baker City six hours away. There it was in my hand. I thought, "How strange is this?" "How is this possible?" I fell asleep with that dryer ball in my hand all night. I woke up a few times during the night with it still clutched in my hand. It was the most peaceful sleep I had experienced in a very long time. Sometimes you just know without explanation that the Lord is with you with a tender regard. This was one of those times.

The next day my perplexity prompted me to relate my experience to one of the administrators of the camp meeting asking whether the people who cleaned the rooms and washed the sheets used little pink spikey dryer balls. I showed her what it looked like hoping she would not think I was insane. She had no idea if they used dryer balls but apparently was intrigued by my experience and unbeknownst to me asked the owner (who is also the one who does all the laundry) whether they used little pink spikey dryer balls when doing the laundry. The administrator approached me later that day and said, "Well, that dryer ball is yours because the owner had no idea what I was talking about." I was touched that she had taken the trouble to ask the owner. She really did not think I was insane.

A few days after we got home I did some experimenting with the dryer ball and my PJ's wondering if it was somehow stuck in my pants and I did not know it, and that it popped out into the bed when I laid down. I folded the dryer ball in the PJ bottoms and then unfolded them to put them on, but the dryer ball fell out every time I unfolded the bottoms. So, I put the bottoms on and dropped the dryer ball into them to see if it could possibly be there without me noticing and stay there while walking around. The dryer ball managed to stay there at the very bottom next to my ankle, but I noticed it because, well, it is spikey. But it would only stay there if I put the bottoms on first THEN dropped the dryer ball into them. I thought if the dryer ball had actually stayed in my bottoms while walking around without me noticing, why would they suddenly pop out while lying down and somehow roll over all its uneven spikes to the foot of the bed? I believe this whole thing was a genuine miracle - a dryer ball transported by an angel hundreds of miles and deposited between the sheets of a bed in a room randomly chosen for us. Not only that, there were two beds in the room. I did not want to keep Gerald awake in case I had to get up in the middle of the night so we slept in separate beds. I

unwittingly chose the bed with the dryer ball hiding between the sheets.

I believe Jesus when He said, "I will be with you always even unto the end of the world." I believe it because it is written and therefore it is true. I was not looking for reassurance nor did I believe my Father in heaven had abandoned me. But for some reason, He revealed an extra special tender regard for me using a weird little spikey pink dryer ball.

Brethren, with the beloved John I call upon you to "behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God." What love, what matchless love, that, sinners and aliens as we are, we may be brought back to God and adopted into His family! We may address Him by the endearing name, "Our Father," which is a sign of our affection for Him and a pledge of His tender regard and relationship to us. And the Son of God, beholding the heirs of grace, "is not ashamed to call them brethren." They have even a more sacred relationship to God than have the angels who have never fallen. 5T 739.3

God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we are now justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. Romans 5:8, 9, RSV.

Self-denial and the cross lie directly in the pathway of every follower of Christ. The cross is that which crosses the natural affections and the will. If the heart is not wholly sanctified to God, if the will and affections and thoughts are not brought into subjection to the will of God, there will be a failure to carry out the principles of true religion and to exemplify in the life the life of Christ (Testimonies for the Church 2:651).

The followers of Christ should value souls as He valued them. Their sympathies should be with the work of their dear Redeemer, and they should labor to save the purchase of His blood, at any sacrifice. What are money, houses, and lands in comparison with even one soul?

Christ made a full and complete sacrifice, a sacrifice sufficient to save every son and daughter of Adam who should show repentance toward God for having transgressed His law, and manifest faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Yet notwithstanding the sacrifice was ample, but few consent to a life of obedience that they may have this great salvation. Few are willing to imitate His amazing privations, to endure His sufferings and persecutions, and to share His exhausting labor to bring others to the light.... Christ is the Captain of our salvation, and by His own sufferings and sacrifice He has given an example to all His followers that watchfulness and prayer, and persevering effort, were necessary on their part if they

would rightly represent the love which dwelt in His bosom for the fallen race

The Feast of Tabernacles

This is the feast that all the saints were to look forward to. Not only commanded, but joyfully acceptable between heaven and earth. A vital part of the covenant.

Among other things, it was a feast of victory and conclusion. That would mean that during the last Feast of Tabernacles Satan could no longer harass earth's heavenly family.

Talk about relief! Talk about reason for joy! To say nothing of the fact that they had plenty of harvest from their previous year of labor.

Many years later, Paul the apostle, kept the feast at various locations showing that it is the heart that counts the most, and besides, the sanctuary had been destroyed by Rome: To his flock at Corinth Paul wrote:

Let us therefore keep the feast, not with malice and wickedness, but instead with sincerity and truth. From 1st Cor. 5:7

And yes, the true sanctuary is still standing today. John the Revelator saw it there, both apartments and the furniture. Well intact.

"As in vision the apostle John was granted a view of the temple of God in heaven, he beheld there 'seven lamps of fire burning before the throne.' He saw an angel having a golden censor, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden throne which was before the throne." Rev. 4:5; 8:3

Here the prophet was permitted to behold the first apartment of the heavenly sanctuary in heaven; and see there the golden candlestick and the altar of incense in the sanctuary, "seven lamps burning before the throne."

So, the message is clear. Though the sanctuary was in heaven "where robbers can't break in," they continued

to pray toward the new Jerusalem wherein are those whom Paul deemed "the church of the firstborn."

What the early church did, and what today's "Christian" and their leaders say they did are two different things. They took the feast seriously wherever they were, and we would do well to follow the true original leaders.

There is a sanctuary and there are folk who know it to be so, and they meet to honor the Feast of Tabernacles and He that is represented there. We thus connect ourselves to heaven, the sanctuary, and its Creator.

Nothing between my soul and my Savior, so that His blessed face may be seen. Nothing preventing the least of His favor: Keep the way clear! Let nothing between.

VEGAN RECIPE CORNER!



TOFU BREAKFAST SCRAMBLE

1 SERVING (So make sure to double or triple it!)

4 oz firm tofu

1 tbsp avocado oil (substitute olive or coconut oil)

1/4 cup yellow onion, diced

1 tsp nutritional yeast

1/8 tsp garlic powder

1/8 tsp turmeric

salt, to taste

1 cup baby spinach

1/2 Roma tomato, diced (optional)

1/4 cup vegan cheddar cheese

1 scallion sliced (optional, for garnish)

DIRECTIONS

To begin, wrap the tofu in a paper towel and squeeze out as much moisture as you can.

Heat the oil in a skillet over medium heat, and sauté the onion until softened.

Add tofu to skillet and break down with a fork until it resembles scrambled eggs.

Sprinkle in nutritional yeast, garlic powder, turmeric, and salt. Stir to coat tofu with the seasoning. You may adjust seasoning to taste. Add the spinach, tomatoes, and cheddar to tofu mixture. Cook until spinach wilts and cheese melts. Enjoy!

CURRIED BUTTERNUT SQUASH AND APPLE SOUP

This vegan soup recipe is adapted from many that have cream added to them, and even though it obviously has no milk products, it is completely rich, creamy, and delicious.

Ingredients:

- 1 small butternut squash, peeled and chopped
- 2 small sweet potatoes, chopped
- 1 sweet onion, chopped
- 1 apple, preferable Granny Smith, cored and quartered
- 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- 2 cloves garlic
- 1 tsp. curry
- 4 cups water and vegetable stock

DIRECTIONS

Sautee the onions in olive oil with a dash of salt until brown and caramelized, about 15 minutes.

Add the garlic and cook for one more minute, then add curry, sweet potatoes, and butternut squash and cook until just tender, about 10-15 minutes.

Add the apple and cook for a few more minutes, until the apple is slightly softened.

Add the stock and water mixture, return to a boil, cover the pot, and then reduce to a simmer for about 25-30 minutes until the vegetables squish when you touch them with the spoon.

Use an immersion blender or transfer to a regular blender like the Vitamix until the mixture is smooth, but still slightly chunky.

Serve this vegan soup recipe warm. Delicious! Serves 4-6

WHITE BEAN SPREAD

(Vegan Nutristionista)

There are many ways to vary the recipe to your tastes. I love this on a sandwich with greens or just as a dip with veggies and crackers.

Ingredients:

- 2 cups cooked white beans (navy or cannellini) or 1 15 ounce can
- 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- 1-2 Tbsp. herbes de provence (or thyme, rosemary, parsley)

1/2 tsp. salt

3 cloves roasted garlic (put garlic in oven for 20 minutes at 375 degrees)

DIRECTIONS

Blend all ingredients together in the Vitamix or mash with a fork.

Makes about 2.5 cups of dip.

Variations:

You can sub out any herbs you like for the herbes de provence. I have had a great version of this with rosemary alone, but I have also seen recipes with red pepper flakes and savory.
